The VIII Latin-American Algorithms, Graphs and Optimization Symposium (LAGOS) was held on 11-15 May 2015 in Praia das Fontes, Beberibe, Ceará, Brazil. LAGOS is the union of two Latin American Conferences on these subjects: the Brazilian Symposium on Graphs Algorithms and Combinatorics (GRACO) and the Latin American Conference on Combinatorics, Graphs and Applications (LACGA). Contributions arising from papers given at a conference should be substantially extended, and should cite the conference paper where appropriate.

All articles will be thoroughly refereed according to the high standards of *Discrete Applied Mathematics*.

The full papers must be submitted through the Elsevier Editorial System (<u>http://ees.elsevier.com/dam</u>). When submitting your paper, be sure to specify that the paper is a contribution for the Special Issue of LAGOS-2015, so that your paper will be assigned to the guest editors. Please see the Author Instructions on the site if you have not yet submitted a paper through this web-based system. Be sure to note that your work is intended for the Special Issue and to select the article type **SI: LAGOS 2015**.

The deadline for submission is **December 31, 2015.** Accepted papers will be published online individually, before print publication. We are looking forward to receiving your contribution.
